Africa on Foot Wilderness Trails is located in the Maseke Balule Game Reserve in the Greater Kruger, situated between Hoedspruit and Phalaborwa in Limpopo Province. It is an 8000 hectare private game reserve, which shares open borders with the Kruger National Park.

Guests taking a road transfer from the airport will need to be dropped off at the Three Bridges Restaurant, where one of our representatives will come and collect you. Self-drivers will also need to drive to the Three Bridges Restaurant, where they will leave their car.

From OR Tambo

Take the N12 or N4 highway to Witbank / eMalahleni (from Johannesburg Airport, follow signs to Boksburg to find the N12). Follow the N4 highway past Middleburg (Toll Plaza), Belfast and Machadodorp (Toll Plaza). Follow the Schoemanskloof option on the N4 and then take the R36 to Lydenburg/ Mashishing.

Follow the R36 to Ohrigstad, go through the Strydom Tunnel and take the R527 to Hoedspruit. Turn left onto the R40. Follow the R40 towards Phalaborwa. Continue on the

R40 for about 25 km until you see the Three Bridges Restaurant on the left.

The landmark is a massive bridge over a river. You will leave your car at Three Bridges, which will be locked behind the gate.

From Hoedspruit

It's roughly 25 km from Hoedspruit to the Three Bridges Restaurant. Follow the R40 from Hoedspruit towards Phalaborwa. Continue on the R40 (the road eventually turns into the R530 as you get close to Phalaborwa) and on the left you will see the Three Bridges Restaurant.

From Phalaborwa

Take the R71 from Phalaborwa and turn left onto the R40 (R530). Continue towards Hoedspruit and on the right hand side you will see the Three Bridges Restaurant.
