SUNDESTINATIONS™



Xaxaba Mobile Camp is located in the midst of the myriad of waterways of the Okavango Delta, and is only accessible via water transfer from a safari airstrip. Guests will not be able to self-drive to the destination, and need fly to one of Botswana's international airports and catch a connecting, light air flight to Xaxaba's closest airstrip (Xaxaba Airstrip).

GPS: XAXAIR 19°33.220'S; 23°03.510'E

LOCATION

Xaxaba is a mobile camp run by Afrika Ecco Safaris from the local community. It is located in the heart of the Okavango Delta and overlooks the famous Chief's Island. The location is between Eagle Island and Chief's Island, making it a pristine and untouched area with abundant wildlife, and offers the best of both land and water based safaris. There are three locations on the island which are used for camping.

HOW TO GET THERE

Guests will arrive in Botswana at Maun Airport and they will need to take a small light air transfer to Xababa Airstrip. Guests can also connect from Kasane Airport Xaxaba Airstrip. However, Maun is the closest. From the local airstrip it is a 20 minute scenic boat ride to the island.

** Guests will fly in small seater plane to the airstrip. Planes are small and don't have the capacity to haul large baggage. Passenger's luggage (including hand luggage) does not exceed 20kg. Luggage dimensions should not exceed 25cm (10 inches) wide, 30cm (12 inches) high and 62 cm (24 inches) long. Anything larger and the luggage will unfortunately not fit in the aircraft's baggage compartment.*
